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






#### STATEMENT BY FESTIVAL PRODUCERS

Inaugurated in 2021, the Otiomuise Live Arts Festival (OLAF) is an annual live arts festival that aims to bridge everyday life and the arts in Windhoek, by offering opportunities for live artistic forms to be showcased and/or exhibited within the city's public spaces. Coproduced by the National Theatre of Namibia (NTN) and Goethe-Institut Namibia (GI). OLAF is largely brought about by the inaccessibility of the majority of Windhoek's inhabitants to various artistic expressions: often limited to indoor, and at times, inaccessible areas of the city. Thus, OLAF offers opportunities for immersive, experimental, and refreshing artistic forms to be showcased or installed in public sites where life and the arts can meet. This is to reflect not only the city's environmental character, but also its rich heritage and artistic expressions that it holds, which its inhabitants need to be impacted by.

The name Otjomuise, stems from the Otjiherero name for the city, which means 'place of steam'. The name of the festival reflects not only the city's unique environmental character, but also its rich heritage and searing creativity to impact its inhabitants.

For eight days, the programme features free small-scaled installations, screenings, murals, performances, and public engagements spread across the city. The themes cover a wide range, offering various conversations and opportunities for the city's inhabitants to reflect on.

Set to take place on an annual basis, the festival ultimately aims to contribute towards a city that enables dynamic and accessible live artistic forms for critical engagements and leisure between the city's creative production and inhabitants.





Local artists Petrus Amuthenu and Frans Uunona who have recently completed their large public mural, will take listeners on their journey on creating the work. This talk will include an overview of the logistical and creative process of what it takes to commission and produce a public mural within Windhoek's frames.

A Theatre for Young Audiences (TYA) work that follows the competition between Ding Dong and Tik Tok to win the heart of the most beautiful Moe. However, all the invested strategies keep failing till both Ding Dong and Tik Tok lose the comical battle.

Q.SURROUNDINGS brings together the perspective of 5 young queer people on queerness, normativity and the desire for safer queer utopian spaces.

This Namibian-Austrian-German ensemble brings together through combining, comparing and sharing their stories, as they narrate their different perspectives and lived experiences.

Stories from Childhood is an operatic retelling of life growing in Windhoek, a northeast area known as Katutura. This retelling, based on stories from matriarchs of families, including, Ulenga's mother, will utilize Namibian music and cultural references to teleport the audience back to a different time, filled with its complexities and its own way, ease of life.

Sigera Jazz & Fusion Band is a six-piece live performing band that was called to life in 2006 by retired musicians. The ensemble will offer a live music concert composed of southern, folk iazz.


